Marteloscopes as outdoor learning sites – experiences so far and what next?

Date: 07 – 08.07.2020

Place: Kandern, Germany

The Integrate Manager Workshop is organised by the European Forest Institute in cooperation with WSL. It will be held prior to the 'oForest Conference' which takes place from 08-10.07.2020. The workshop aims at bringing together the Integrate Network of Marteloscope Managers and other interested actors.

Marteloscope sites are currently used for field training around the topics integrative, multifunctional forest management, forest ecosystem services and forest biodiversity, in research and as a tool for communication. To date more than 90 such sites have been established across 16 European countries – and their number continues to grow. The workshop will address the following themes:

- Exchange of experiences gained with Marteloscopes over the past years and where lie development potentials?
- How to effectively implement training and education for different target groups and topics in such sites?
- What are current applications and future options for using Marteloscopes in research?
- How to utilise Marteloscopes in fact-based communication?

The above includes also the collection of proposals for additional training applications and software tools/modules for addressing additional topics or tailoring to specific target audiences.
